2. Education economics

Human capital investment, returns to education, social interaction and peereffect in education, effect of educational reforms

3. Health economics

Individual health decisions, health over the life-cycle, environment and health, health and work, safety standards & work injuries

4. Applied micro-econometrics

Empirical strategy design, natural experiments, treatment effects models, matching methods, non-parametric method, policy evaluation methods
