Course Aims

The aim of the course, through the initial exposition of the numerous changes that in the recent years have characterized the figure of the agricultural entrepreneur, is to introduce the students to all the new areas of law that are now directly affected by the development of this figure and, particularly, the most recent innovations in the field of business crisis law and industrial law but also competition law.

Methodology

Lectures with the help of power point presentations, during the course abstracts of the most recent sentences on the subject, and of the main articles published in the recent years, will also be distributed.

Course description

The course will be divided into four lessons, the first two will address the most general characteristics of the evolution of the agricultural entrepreneur starting from the 2001 reform which has re-elaborated the main guide-lines of the subject, up to the most recent legislative changes. Particularly, then, the second part of the course will be dedicated to the latest news regarding the importance today recognized to this figure in the context of a business crisis, as in all the problems related to the protection of agricultural products, but also about their advertising on the markets; even on the basis of the most recent Directives at European level.
