Steps of the research

- Analysis of the characteristics and of the economic operators and stakeholders
- Assessment of the sustainability practices of the operators in the meat supply chain;
- Identification of the core elements and critical factors that characterize the sustainable management of the meat supply chain;
- Evaluation of the impact of business activity at the different levels of the supply chain;
- Identification of areas of improvement for business processes;
- Implementation of more sustainable business practices.

Main Results

Development of a model for the measurement and reporting of the value generated by companies along the supply chain

Research Contribution

When validated this model will allow the positioning of companies belonging to the different steps of the meat supply chain with respect to sustainability issues according to a multi-dimensional approach.
